

Inspiral Education Privacy Policy

We care about how your personal information (also known as “personal data”) is used and shared. How we do that is written in this Privacy Policy (the "Policy"), which forms part of, and is incorporated into, our Terms of Use. It is important you read through this Policy and, if you are a student, be sure to get your parent(s)/guardian(s) to read and discuss it with you. If you are a student, your school should have asked for and obtained your parent(s)/guardian(s)' consent for you to disclose your personal information to Inspirational Education. If you are under 13 and your parent(s)/guardian(s) have not given their consent to use the Inspirational Education Platform, then please do not use the Inspirational Education Platform. By providing Inspirational Education with your information, you confirm that you are over 13 years old or your parent(s)/guardian(s) have given their consent to disclosing your personal information to us and agree to the terms of this Policy. In the event we discover we have collected information from a child who is under 13 and for whom we do not have parental/guardian consent, we will either delete the information or immediately seek the parent's/guardian's consent for that collection. Inspirational Education promises to look after and control any information you add to our Inspirational Education Platform, whether it's personal information (such as your name, email address or photos) or other non-personal information (such as your nickname, your views or comments).

Any personal information provided to or gathered by the Inspirational Education Platform is controlled by TGA Education Limited, a limited liability company incorporated in the United Kingdom, company number 09501467, with a registered office at 6 Hill Road, London, United Kingdom, NW8 9QG ("Inspirational Education"). Inspirational Education is a data controller for the purposes of the 2018 General Data Protection Regulation (the "Act"). This Policy does not apply to the practices of other websites or companies that Inspirational Education does not own or control, or to individuals that Inspirational Education does not employ or manage.

1. GENERAL

The information we gather (including personal information) from you enables us to personalise and improve the Inspirational Education Platform. We retain personal data for only as long as is necessary for our business operations and for compliance purposes, and delete personal information when it is no longer necessary for the purposes set out in this Policy. Any and all information you provide to us is hosted and stored on cloud servers owned by third parties, which may be located outside of the European Economic Area ("EEA"). By accepting these Terms when you first log on to the Inspirational Education Platform (or by your parent signing the parental consent form), you explicitly agree to us transferring your personal information outside of the EEA for these purposes. Inspirational Education may amend this Policy from time to time. Use of information we collect now is subject to the Policy in effect at the time such information is used. If we make changes in the way we use personal data, we will notify you in writing or by posting a change on the Inspirational Education Platform (and, if you are a student, ask your parents(s)/guardian(s) to consent to these). If the changes are significant or the way that we use your personal data changes, we may provide a more prominent notice or get your consent as required by law.

2. WHAT PERSONAL DATA DOES INSPIRAL COLLECT?

We receive and store any information you enter on the Inspirational Education Platform or provide to us in any other way. The types of personal data collected include your name, email address, photo (if submitted by you), your profile information and any other information necessary for us to provide the Inspirational Education Platform.

3. WHAT ABOUT COOKIES?

The Inspiral Education Platform uses cookies. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. They help us to improve the Inspiral Education Platform and to deliver a better and more personalised service. They enable us to store information about your preferences and to recognise you when you return to the Inspiral Education Platform. You may refuse to accept cookies by activating the setting on your browser which allows you to refuse the setting of cookies. However, if you select this setting then you may be unable to access certain parts of the Inspiral Education Platform. Unless you have adjusted a browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you log on to the Inspiral Education Platform.

4. WHAT WILL INSPIRAL DO WITH THE DATA THAT YOU SHARE WITH US?

We use the information and personal data we collect from you to: deliver the Inspiral Education Platform to you and other users; ensure that content from the Inspiral Education Platform is presented in the most effective manner for users and improve the Inspiral Education Platform; communicate with you about the Inspiral Education Platform (including service announcements and administrative messages, which you cannot opt out of); allow you to participate in interactive features of the Inspiral Education Platform, when you choose to do so; administer your Inspiral Education account(s) and update our records; prevent or detect abuses of the Inspiral Education Platform; and enable third parties to carry out technical, logistical or other functions on our behalf. We may release personal data when we believe in good faith that release is necessary to comply with the law, regulation or legal request; enforce or apply our conditions of use and other agreements; or protect the rights, property, or safety of Inspiral Education, our employees, our users, or others.

5. WHAT PERSONAL DATA CAN YOU ACCESS AND WHAT CHOICES DO YOU HAVE?

Inspiral Education allows you to access the following information for the purpose of viewing, and in certain situations, updating that information: your name; email address; display name and password; profile picture; and user preferences. The Act gives you the right to access information held about you. The right of access can be exercised in accordance with the Act. Any access request may be subject to a fee of £10 to meet our costs in providing you with details of the information held about them. You may at any time request correction or deletion of personal data, and object to any processing of personal data by emailing us at team@inspireeducation.com. You can always opt not to disclose information, even though it may be needed to take advantage of the Inspiral Education Platform or other features of the Inspiral Education Platform. Please note that after your account is closed, we may retain your personal information as needed to comply with our legal and regulatory obligations, resolve disputes, investigate or prevent fraud and other inappropriate activity. In addition, any content that you submit may remain on the Inspiral Education Platform, after deletion of your account.
